

As a leader, my goal is to elevate my co-workers and support their work so that we can do more together. Part of this is mentoring and setting motivating goals while taking the interests of the company into account. During my years as an executive, I successfully implemented the OKR system that aligns personal and organizational goals with Maform, as well as efficiency tools and solutions such as Timely, which facilitates time tracking, Dropbox Paper, which facilitates documentation culture, and Lessons Learned, which helps share and describe project experiences.

The success of my efforts is marked by the many recognitions Maform received, including the Entrepreneurial Quality Award of the Hungarian National Committee of the European Organization for Quality, the Award for Lovely Workplaces, and more tan a dozen of professional design awards. More than 30 people worked at the company during this time, and the full time team size varied from 6 to 12, bringing the company to a significant size among the regional design studios. We built an active alumni group, most employees joined illustrious international companies (e.g. BMW, Philips, Prezi) or set up their own company (e.g. Clift) after their Maform years.
